Asian/Pacific American Heritage Month (APAHM)

is to celebrate and pay tribute to the contributions that generations of Asian/Pacific Americans have made to American history, society, and culture.



- APAHM originated in 1978 when passed by Congress. This law directed President Carter to issue a proclamation designating the week beginning on May 4, 1979 as Asian Pacific American Heritage Week. President George H.W. Bush later issued a proclamation designating May 1990 as the first Asian American Heritage Month.


- Violence against Asian Americans and Asians has grown despite increased national attention and political action against anti-Asian hate.
- There was more than a 164% increase in anti-Asian hate crime reports to police in the first quarter of 2021 in 16 major cities and jurisdictions compared with last year.
